8-4-11 photo id-absentee voting

The Fond du Lac County Clerk says a Republican legislator was surprised to find out a new voter photo id bill has a different standard for absentee ballots. Clerk Lisa Freiberg says Republican Assemblyman, Richard Spanbauer didn't realize that once a voter has provided photo ID with their absentee application they are not required to provide photo ID again with subsequent absentee ballot requests, unless their registration status changes. "If you are an absentee voter as the law is written right now you only have to show your drivers license once and as long as you don't change your name or your address that is your one proof only," Freiberg said. "So in ten years if I haven't changed my name or my address my drivers license from ten years ago even though it may be expired is still good enough for absentee ballot to be received to my home address." Freiberg says if voter fraud is the real concern she wonders why there is a difference in the photo ID requirement for someone voting by absentee ballot compared to the person voting at the polls?

8-4-11 three drug arrest suspects make court appearance

Bail has been set at \$50,000 cash for a Fond du lac man arrested in a drug bust last week. Twenty seven year old, Michael McReynolds, made his initial Fond du lac court appearance this week on charges of maintaining a drug trafficking place, possession of THC and cocaine with intent to deliver and bail jumping. Bail was set at \$5000 cash for 26 year old, Gregory Jones, of Chicago on party to the crime of maintaining a drug trafficking place and possession with intent to deliver cocaine and THC. A third person, 20 year old Chrisett Nordmeier of Fond du Lac is free on a signature bond on the same drug charges. According to a criminal complaint police confiscated a half pound of marijuana during a search of a Martin Avenue residence and found cocaine and marijuana at a Division Street residence.

8-4-11 sex assault investigation continues

Fond du Lac police are continuing their investigation following the arrest of a Fond du lac man in the violent sexual assault of a Fond du Lac woman. Police Captain of Detectives, Mike Frank, says the suspect was arrested less than 24 hours after the incident was reported in the 100 block of Morningside Drive on July 23rd. "We have a victim in this case who was a very good witness, was able to provide a very good physical description of this party and it started to narrow the search for us and it was one of those things where we looked specifically for this person and were able to determine where he was," Frank said. Frank says police also believe the suspect was involved in three downtown business burglaries. "He was actually observed at one of the businesses prior to a reported burglary later that day. Based on history and a few other things he was definitely a person of interest that we wanted to talk to about those things anyway," Frank said. The suspect remains in the Fond du lac County Jail on a parole violation hold.

8-4-11 delinquent water bills

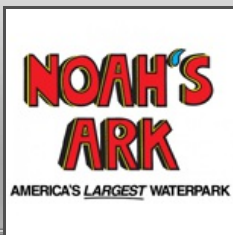
A former Fond du lac city councilmember is defending a bill that would prohibit municipalities from placing delinquent utility bills on landlord's tax bills. Republican state representative, Jeremy Thiesfeldt, is a sponsor of AB 182. Thiesfeldt says landlords should not have to pay for their tenant's failure to pay their water bill. "There are no easy answers to it but what I'm looking for is a fairness issue," Thiesfeldt said. "I understand, I pay water bills in Fond du lac too and its no fun with the increases that there have been. But I think the average person looks at this and says yeah, that is unfair." Councilmember Rick Gudex has initiated a resolution in opposition to the Assembly bill. Gudex says if the bill passes all Fond du Lac residents would see an increase in their water bills. Thiesfeldt says he doesn't think there would be much of a financial impact.

8-4-11 recall-spending

MADISON, Wis. (AP) — A government watchdog organization reports nearly 30 outside groups have spent millions in Wisconsin's Senate recall elections. The Wisconsin Democracy Campaign reports today that 29 groups that are required to register campaign fund-raising and spending with state election officials reported spending \$12.5 million in the recalls.

8-4-11 ag secretary vilsack

MILWAUKEE (AP) — U.S. Agriculture Secretary Tom Vilsack says the government hopes to find the source of a salmonella outbreak linked to ground turkey "very, very" soon. Vilsack told The Associated Press from Milwaukee today that investigators are working with producers to identify a source and then will encourage the industry to issue a recall.
